IN TOUCH WITH OUTREACH

Adjusting to Coronavirus! Since March 18th, the Lombard/Villa Park Food Pantry has been operating a drive-through distribution to minimize contact for guests and volunteers and respect social distancing. Guests receive a pre-packed box of non-perishable staple foods as well as a prepacked box of meat, produce, milk and eggs. Between March 18th and April 17th, there were 657 visits from 471 unduplicated households. This is double the average numbers before the coronavirus crisis caused job loss and hardship for many of our neighbors.
