

IN TOUCH WITH OUTREACH

Anyone who needs help or knows someone who needs assistance in paying rent, the 2021 Illinois Rental Payment Program is accepting applications NOW.

The Housing Development Authority (IHDA) launched its rental payment program (ILRPP) for Illinois residents impacted by COVID-19.

Approved applicants will be eligible for up to 15 months of assistance through this grant, which will cover 12 months of past due rent as well as cover 3 months' worth of future rent payments. This is a joint application process which needs to be started by the landlord and completed by the tenant.
